### QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Age Limit : Not more than 40 years old on the day of examination, preferably single;
2. Height : Female – 5'2 and above  
Male – 5'4 and above
3. Physical/Mental Condition : Must be physically and mentally fit and of good moral character and not color blind;
4. Educational Background : Completion of two (2) years studies in college or at least seventy-two (72) units;
5. Eligibility : None Required
6. Work Experience : None Required

Submit duly accomplished application form together with the following documents:


- a) Diploma / Transcript of Records (authenticated copy);

**on or before July 13, 2018 at 5:00 PM** at Mactan – Cebu International Airport, CAAP, or at Tagbilaran Airport. Documents may be submitted in person or via mail/courier. (*See list of Testing Centers for details*)

Successful examinees will undergo panel interview and physical/mental examinations.

Successful applicants will be trained for free. However there will be no allowance or any form of remuneration during the training period. Food, accommodation, clothing and transportation will not be provided.
