Bid Bulletin No. 01 (to be enclosed in the Technical Components and to be marked accordingly) is hereby issued for the information of prospective bidders relative to the bidding of Purchase of Four (4) Units PAPI Setting Instrument for Air Navigation Operations Department.

- A. For information of all Prospective bidders:
- a. Similar project means "Airfield Lighting Accessories".
 - b. Delivery period should not be more than forty five (45) calendar days from receipt of Purchase Order.
 - c. No dealership requirement.
- B. For clarification on the proper sealing and marking of bids, (i.e., envelope system), please feel free to approach the Secretariat. Any interpretations contrary to what is stipulated by the BAC will not be acceptable and shall be a ground for disqualification.
- C. On the additional Instruction on the Sealing and markings of bids (ITB Clause 20.1 on the Bid Data Sheet), the documents must be properly tabbed with corresponding annex label (i.e., Annex A, Annex B, or Bid Security, etc. and all pages sequentially paginated i.e., page 1 of 5 pages, 2 of 5 pages, etc. as the case may be). Failure to comply with this requirement will be ground for disqualification.
- D. In addition to the other requirements stipulated in the issued documents, prospective bidders shall further accomplish the attached the attached Bid bulletin No. 01 dated January 30, 2012 to form part of the technical components.
- E. Submission of Sealed Eligibility Documents and Bid Documents (Technical and Financial Components) should not be later than **2:00 PM, 07 February 2012** at the BAC Secretariat, Ground Floor, New FSIS Building, MIA Road, Pasay City and publicly opened thereafter.
- F. The CAAP-BAC reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive defects or formality therein and to accept bids considered responsive and most advantageous to the Government.
