



Bid Bulletin No. 01

Bid Bulletin No. 01 (to be enclosed in the Technical Proposal) is hereby issued for the information of all prospective bidders relative to the bidding for the **Supply, Delivery and Installation of UPS Batteries at Manila Radar Approach Facility**.

- A. For information of Prospective bidders the additional specifications:
1. Dimensions: H=33cm, W=15cm, L=17cm
 2. Valve Regulated Lead Acid, Gel Type, 2 volts, 300AH
 3. Batteries for 100KVA, Mitsubishi UPS
 4. The power supply to the load should not be interrupted during the installation of batteries.
 5. The bidder must submit proof that they have track record in supplying and installing UPS or acceptable Industrial batteries for the last three (3) years such as Certificate of Completion and Acceptance.
 6. The bidder must submit Battery Manufacturer's Distribution Certificate duly authenticated by the Philippine Embassy, or any document that would attest that there is a pending application.
 7. The bidder must submit certification from the manufacturer that the batteries to be supplied are manufactured recently. (6 months)
 8. Prospective bidder are required to conduct site inspection (see attached Form)
 9. For clarification on the proper sealing and markings of bids, (i.e., envelope system), please feel free to approach the Secretariat. Any interpretations contrary to the stipulated by the BAC will not be acceptable and shall be a ground for disqualification.
 10. On the additional Instruction on Sealing and Markings of Bids (ITB Clause 20.1 on the Bid Data Sheet), the documents must be properly tabbed with corresponding annex label (i.e., Annex A, Annex B, or Bid Security, etc.) and all pages sequentially paginated (i.e., page 1 of 5 pages, page 2 of 5 pages, etc, as the case may be). Failure to comply with this requirement will be a ground for disqualification.
 11. In addition to the other requirements stipulated in the issued bid documents prospective bidders shall further accomplish the attached Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated 27 January 2010 to form part of the Technical Proposal.
- B. Submission of Sealed Eligibility and Bid Documents (Technical and Financial Proposals) shall be not later than 2:00PM, 09 February 2010 at the BAC Secretariat, Ground Floor, CAAP Main Building, MIA Road, Pasay City and publicly opened thereafter.
- C. The CAAP-BAC reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive defects or formality therein and to accept bids considered responsive and most advantageous to the Government.
