Invitation to Bid for
Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Airfield Lighting System for Tuguegarao, Legaspi & Puerto Princesa Airports

The *Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP)*, through the CAAP Corporate Budget CY 2012 intends to apply the sum amounts being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Airfield Lighting System for the following Airports:

A. *Tuguegarao Airport* *Php. 49,636,346.50*

B. *Legaspi Airport* *Php. 19,899,762.48*

C. *Puerto Princesa Airport* *Php. 9,540,186.42*

Total ABC: PhP 79,076,295.40

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) now invites bids for the following:

A. *Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of Airfield Lighting System at Tuguegarao, Legazpi and Puerto Princesa Airports* (see attached specification for detailed requirements per airport). Completion of the Works is required within One Hundred Fifty (150) Calendar Days. Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract Navigational Aids (Airfield Lighting System) Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from *Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP)* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8AM to 5PM Monday to Friday.

5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of **Php 79,100.00**

It *may also be downloaded* from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that bidders shall pay the fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

6. The **Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP)** will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on 2:00PM of January 24, 2012 at DDG's Conference Room, G/F New FSIS Building, MIA Road, Pasay City, which shall be open to all interested parties.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 2:00PM of February 6, 2012 at BAC Office, G/F New FSIS Building, MIA road, Pasay City. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.

Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.


8. Prospective bidders shall possess a valid Category "B" PCAB License in "General Engineering" as Principal Classification and shall be Medium "A" for Navigational Facilities-AGL Installation in Registration Particular (IAC), have completed a similar contract with a value of at least 50% of ABC with same in nature and complexity to the contract, have key personnel and equipment (listed in the Eligibility Forms) available for the prosecution of the contract and meet the other minimum eligibility requirements stated in the Eligibility Documents and Eligibility Data Sheet. The BAC will use non-discretionary pass/fail criteria in the Eligibility Check / Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids. The BAC will conduct post-qualification of the lowest calculated bid.

9. The **Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines CAAP** reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to annul the bidding process any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
