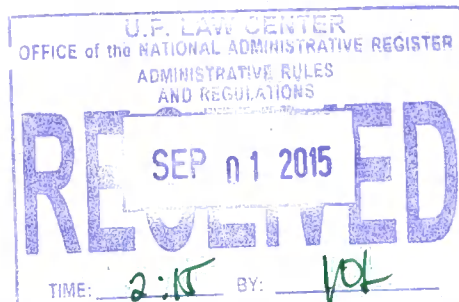

SUBJECT : EXTENSION OF COMPLIANCE DATE TO CAAP AD/GENERAL/002 – SUPPLEMENTAL OXYGEN SUPPLY ON VARIOUS TRANSPORT CATEGORY AIRCRAFT

CAAP AD/General/002 requires the installation of a supplemental oxygen system in the lavatories of passenger carrying airplanes by 10 September 2015.

Several requests were received by this Authority for an extension of time to comply with the issued CAAP Airworthiness Directive (CAAP AD/General/002 dated 14 June 2013) in view of purchasing issues encountered by the concerned AOC holders attributed to delayed shipment of parts, late issuance of design approvals, customs clearances, customs releases and scheduling for aircraft modification, all of which are beyond the control of the operators.


After careful evaluation and technical-consultations with the concerned departments of this Authority, compliance date to the said Airworthiness Directive is hereby extended for a period of (6) six months from 10 September 2015. However, effective 10 March 2016, no person may operate any affected Republic of the Philippines-registered civil aircraft unless the provisions under the said Airworthiness Directive have been complied.

EFFECTIVITY:

Fifteen (15) days after publication in a requisite single newspaper of general circulation and a copy filed with the U.P. Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register (ONAR), this Memorandum Circular shall take effect and supersedes any orders and/or memoranda in conflict herewith.
