MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 17-14

TO : ALL FOREIGN AIR OPERATORS
FROM : THE DIRECTOR GENERAL
SUBJECT : OPERATION OF FOREIGN-REGISTERED AIRCRAFT
DATE : 10 JUNE 2014

Pursuant to the regulatory powers and functions of the Director General as provided under Section 55 of Republic Act No. 9497, effective immediately, foreign-registered aircraft owned by Filipino citizens or Philippine-registered corporations are allowed domestic non-revenue flights. Documents of ownership or lease agreement shall be submitted to this Authority.

All other foreign-registered aircraft owned by other nationalities are likewise allowed to conduct domestic flights provided that these are intended for sales demonstration or air ambulance flights only and subject to existing regulations and other requirements that this Authority may impose.


In no case shall a foreign aircraft be used for commercial flights unless they comply with the requirements of the Philippine Civil Aviation Regulations Part 9 (Air Operator Certification and Administration) and other pertinent regulations.

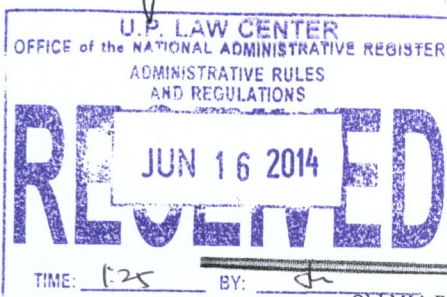
This Memorandum Circular amends Memorandum Circular No. 29-12 dated 27 November 2012 and shall take effect fifteen (15) days after compliance with the requisite single newspaper publication and a copy filed with the UP Law Center – Office of National Administrative Register.
