SUBJECT : AMENDMENTS TO THE PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS

RE: EXTENDING THE VALIDITY PERIOD OF VARIOUS CERTIFICATES

Pursuant to the powers vested on the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines under Republic Act No. 9497, otherwise known as the Civil Aviation Authority Act of 2008 and in accordance with the Regulations Amendment/Revision Procedure with Board Resolution No. 2012-054 dated 28 September 2012, I hereby approve the following amendments to the Philippine Civil Aviation Regulations Parts 3, 6, 9 and 11.

AMENDED REGULATIONS:

**PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS PART 3
APPROVED TRAINING ORGANIZATION**

3.1.2.3 Validity of the Certificate and Renewal

(a) Subject to satisfactory compliance with the requirements of this Part, the validity of the initial certificate is five (5) years. ~~will be valid for 1 year and the validity of a renewed certificate is 3 years.~~

**PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS PART 6
APPROVED MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION**

6.2.1.3 Duration and Renewal of Certificate

(a) A Certificate of Rating issued to an Approved Maintenance Organization is valid for five (5) ~~two (2)~~ years from the date of issuance subject to the compliance with the Approved Maintenance Organization Procedures Manual and the provisions of PCAR Part 6, unless:

- (1) ~~The last day of the 24th month after the date on which it was issued.~~
- (2) The Approved Maintenance Organization surrenders it, or
- (3) The CAAP suspends and revokes it.

~~Note: AMO certificates previously issued without an expiry date will remain valid until the last day of the 24th month after the date on which it was issued.~~

PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS PART 9 AIR OPERATOR CERTIFICATION AND ADMINISTRATION

9.1.1.8 Duration of an Air Operator Certificate

- (a) An AOC, or any portion of the AOC, issued by the Authority is effective for a period of **five (5) years** ~~24 months or such lesser period as may be specified by CAAP~~ and remains valid until:

PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS PART 11 AERIAL WORK AND OPERATING LIMITATIONS FOR NON-TYPE CERTIFICATED AIRCRAFT

11.1.1.8 Duration of A Certificate of Authorization

- (a) A certificate of authorization, issued by the Authority is effective until:
 - (1) Its validity for a period of **five (5)** ~~three (3)~~ years.

11.11.6.9 Validity of RPAS Operator Certificate

- (a) An RPAS Operator Certificate issued by the Authority is effective for a period of **five (5)** ~~three (3)~~ years from date of issuance and remains valid until:



Effectivity - Fifteen (15) days after compliance with the requisite publication in a single newspaper of general circulation and a copy filed with the U.P. Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register, these amendments shall be incorporated to the Philippine CAR, series of 2018.
