- 2. Not more than thirty five (35) years old on January 27, 2024
- 3. Physically, mentally, psychologically fit and of good moral character
- 4. Has not been convicted of criminal or administrative case
- 5. Has not been dishonorably separated from Government or private service

B. Additional Qualifications:

- 1. Bachelor's degree holder of Electronics and Communication Engineering; Electrical Engineering; Computer Engineering; Mechanical Engineering or Aeronautical Engineering
- 2. Career Service Professional (CSP) or R.A. 1080
- 3. Not color blind

Documents may be submitted in person or via mail/courier (see list of Testing Centers and contact details).

Applications with incomplete requirements will not be accepted.

Applicants must pass the nationwide examination on January 27, 2024 (Saturday) to be held simultaneously at <u>Civil Aviation Training Center (CATC)</u> in Pasay and in designated Testing Centers in <u>Puerto Princesa</u>, <u>Naga, Bacolod, Kalibo, Dumaguete, Pagadian, Ozamis, General Santos, Butuan</u>.

Training is free. Allowances, accommodation and other miscellaneous expense during the training period shall <u>not</u> be covered by this Authority.

Successful applicants will be assigned in any Air Navigation Service (ANS) facility nationwide.
