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Further, clarifications received thru email by the BAC Secretariat not answered above are clarified below:

Queries/Questions	Clarification/s
From Aljon International Corporation: If there are tire sizes (365/8 R20 with DOT 2024) that are in stock in Europe warehouses, and can lessen the time of manufacturing and delivery lead time, would the Honorable Committee allow the DOT (Date of Manufacturing) to be 2024? The warranty period will not be changed and still covered by Standard Manufacturer's Warranty upon receipt of delivery and/or Acceptance.	The required DOT for the tires would still be 2025.
From Equilast Incorporated: If the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the project should be 25% of the ABC?	The required SLCC stays at 50%. The 25% under conditions provided for in Sections 23.4.1.3 and 23.4.2.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 refers only to at least two (2) similar contracts aggregate contract amount of at least the percentage of the required ABC. Moreover, the stand-alone 25% project SLCC is applicable to "Expendable Supplies" 25% in accordance with the same provisions abovementioned.

This shall be an integral part of the Bidding Documents and the same shall be enclosed in the technical envelope/ components and shall be marked accordingly. Bids not complying thereto shall be disqualified.
