



**CCC Resolution No. 2025-029**

**"RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF POWER QUALITY ANALYZER, 6000A FLEXIBLE PQA CURRENT CLAMP, THERMAL IMAGER AND 5KV INSULATION TESTER AT ANS TECHNICAL CENTER THROUGH SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF REPUBLIC ACT (RA) NO. 12009"**

**WHEREAS**, Deputy Director General for Administration, Atty. Danjun G. Lucas, has approved the Purchase Request for the Supply and Delivery of Power Quality Analyzer, 6000A PQA Current Clamp, Thermal Imager and 5kV Insulation Tester at ANS Technical Center in accordance with CBA No. 25-05-596 dated 05 May 2025 with a total budget allocation of P1,860,000.00. The approval is documented and attached hereto as **Annex A**, which forms as integral part of this Resolution;

**WHEREAS**, on 02 July 2025, the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines – Contract and Canvass Committee (CAAP-CCC) resolved to procure this project through Small Value Procurement (SVP) pursuant to Section 34 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 12009. Copy of the minutes hereto attached as **Annex B**;

**WHEREAS**, CAAP-CCC, through its Secretariat, posted the Request for Quotation (RFQ) on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), the CAAP website, and in conspicuous locations within CAAP premises on 07 July 2025. A copy of the PhilGEPS postings is hereto attached as **Annex C**;

**WHEREAS**, the Request for Quotation (RFQ) was sent to the following:

**WHEREAS**, during the opening of the sealed quotation held on 17 July 2025 at the CAAP, Procurement Division Office, the CAAP-CCC noted the following:

**WHEREAS**, the end-user evaluation report submitted on 28 July 2025 disclosed that SYSTEMS CONTROLS INSTRUMENTATIONS, INC. did not comply with the additional requirements while CHOMAR UNITRADE SERVICES CO. LTD complied with all CAAP documentary, arithmetic and technical requirements, and was determined to be the lowest calculated and responsive quotation. A copy of the evaluation report is hereto attached as **Annex D**;

**WHEREAS**, Section 34, Subsection 34.3, Paragraph (g) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 12009 provides that: *"The Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) shall recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) the award of contract in favor of the supplier, contractor, or consultant with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB), Most Economically Advantageous Responsive Bid (MEARB), Most Advantageous Responsive Bid (MARB). Or Highest Rated Responsive Bid (HRRB), as applicable."*

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the above premises, the CAAP-CCC **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend for **APPROVAL** of the Supply and Delivery of Power Quality Analyzer, 6000A PQA Current Clamp, Thermal Imager and 5kV Insulation Tester at ANS Technical Center in the total amount of **ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE AND 67/100 PESOS (P1,610,275.67)** only, and be **AWARDED** to **CHOMAR UNITRADE SERVICES CO. LTD**, the offer of which was considered reasonable and advantageous to the Government;
