



## **ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines is launching the **Airfield Lighting and Power Technician's Course Batch 17** to recruit competent young men and women who will join the country's elite line of Air Navigation Technical Personnel.

### **A. General Qualifications:**

1. Natural-born citizen of the Philippines
2. At least twenty (20) years old but not more than thirty-five (35) years old on April 24, 2026
3. Physically, mentally, and psychologically fit and of good moral character.
4. Has not been convicted of a criminal or administrative case
5. Has not been dishonorably separated from Government or private service

### **B. Additional Qualifications:**

1. Completion of two (2) years of studies in college, preferably with a mechanical, electrical, or electronics course, or a high school graduate with a relevant vocational/trade course (mechanical, electrical, or Electronics)
2. Not color-blind

The Technical Application Form may be downloaded from the CAAP website ([www.caap.gov.ph](http://www.caap.gov.ph)) or requested from any designated CAAP Testing Center.

Acceptance of applications will start on **March 9, 2026**. Interested applicants may submit, either personally or via mail/courier, their completed application form together with the documents listed below to the designated testing centers in **Manila, Laoag, Puerto Princesa, Mactan, and Tacloban on or before 5:00 PM on April 10, 2026**.

1. Transcript of Records for two (2) years of studies in college, a copy of the diploma, together with a relevant Vocational/Trade Course Certificate (authenticated copy) for high school graduates
2. NBI Clearance/Police Clearance (original copy)
3. 2 pcs 2x2 photo (colored picture with white background and name tag)

Upon submitting their application, qualified applicants must scan the QR code provided by HRMD. This step is required for them to be officially listed as candidates for the examination. **Applications with incomplete requirements will not be accepted.** Applicants must pass the nationwide examination on **April 24, 2026 (Friday)**, a scheduled interview, and a medical exam on a later date.

Training is free. Allowances, accommodation, and other miscellaneous expenses during the training period shall not be covered by this Authority.

Successful applicants who complete the training will be assigned to any Air Navigation Service (ANS) facility nationwide.
