



ANNOUNCEMENT

The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines is launching the **Communication Navigation Surveillance Systems Officer's (CNSSO) Course Batch 46** to recruit competent young men and women who will join the country's elite line of Air Traffic Safety Electronic Personnel (ATSEP).

A. General Qualifications:

1. Natural-born citizen of the Philippines
2. Not more than thirty-five (35) years old on April 25, 2026
3. Physically, mentally, and psychologically fit and of good moral character
4. Has not been convicted of a criminal or administrative case
5. Has not been dishonorably separated from Government or private service

B. Additional Qualifications:

1. Bachelor's degree holder of Electronics and Communication Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Computer Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, or Aeronautical Engineering
2. Has Career Service Professional (CSP) or RA. 1080 (EcE, EE, and ME)
3. Not color-blind

The Technical Application Form may be downloaded from the CAAP website (www.caap.gov.ph) or requested from any designated CAAP Testing Center.

Acceptance of applications will start on **March 9, 2026**. Interested applicants may submit, either personally or via mail/courier, their completed technical application form together with the documents listed below to the designated testing centers in **Manila, Clark, Puerto Princesa, and Mactan, on or before 5:00 PM on April 10, 2026**.

1. Diploma (photocopy) or Certification from the School Registrar that they completed the course (photocopy)
2. Transcript of Records (photocopy)
3. CSP Eligibility Certificate or R.A. 1080 (photocopy)
4. PSA Birth Certificate (photocopy)
5. NBI Clearance/Police Clearance (original copy)
6. 2 pcs 2x2 photo (colored picture with white background and nametag)

Upon submitting their application, qualified applicants must scan the QR code provided by HRMD. This step is required for them to be officially listed as candidates for the examination. **Applications with incomplete requirements will not be accepted.** Applicants must pass the nationwide examination on **April 25, 2026 (Saturday)**, a scheduled interview, and a medical exam on a later date.

Training is free. Allowances, accommodation, and other miscellaneous expenses during the training period shall not be covered by this Authority.

Successful applicants who complete the training will be assigned to any Air Navigation Service (ANS) facility nationwide.
