**AMENDMENT TO PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS (PCAR)
PART 2, RE: AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLER AND AERONAUTICAL STATION
OPERATOR LICENSES**

DATE : 13 APRIL 2026

In line with the continuing efforts to enhance regulatory compliance and align national standards with international aviation requirements, this is to inform all concerned personnel and stakeholders of the forthcoming amendment to the regulations governing the issuance, renewal, and maintenance of Air Traffic Controller (ATC) and Aeronautical Station Operator (ASO) licenses.

The amendments aim to:

1. Ensure alignment with updated international standards and recommended practices;
2. Strengthen competency, qualification, and proficiency requirements for license holders;
3. Improve oversight mechanisms for licensing, validation, and currency of privileges; and
4. Promote a higher level of safety, efficiency, and reliability in air navigation services.
